



**FAQ: UNITN INTERNAL CALLS** (last update: 18 August 2014)

**STARTING GRANT YOUNG RESEARCHERS 2014**

- 1) **Q: May an applicant to "Starting Grant" participate in a "Research Projects 2014" proposal as research team member?**

**A:** Yes.

- 2) **Q: Will the applicant eligibility requirements (PhD award date no more than 12 years prior the date of the publication of the call, with the exception of extension in duly justified cases - e.g. maternity and paternity leave, long term illness - up to max 16 years and 6 months) be calculated without any exception?**

**A:** Yes, the call does not admit any further exception to the duly justified maximum extensions.

- 3) **Q: Are the following costs eligible?**

- the purchase of equipment to test the feasibility of a project idea?

**A:** No, these costs are classified as research costs.

**STARTING GRANT YOUNG RESEARCHERS 2014**

- 1) **Q: Is someone applying for a Marie Skłodowska Curie European Fellowship eligible, considering that he/she will be hosted and recruited by a foreign Host institution?**

**A:** Yes.

- 2) **Q: Can an applicant involve other people that do not meet the eligibility criteria foreseen for the applicant? If yes, are they eligible for funding under this project (e.g. travel costs for research group members other than young researchers) ?**

**A:** The proposal can be submitted by one or more applicants. They all have to meet the eligibility criteria indicated in the call and they are the only beneficiaries of the grant.



**3) Q: If the proposal is submitted by two applicants is it allowed that one of the two applicants will not participate in the target competitive call?**

**A: Yes.**

**4) Q: Are the following costs eligible?**

**- editing or translation of the project proposal?**

**A: Yes, if they do not represent the major component of the budget.**

**- a contract for the applicant (co.co.co.)?**

**A: No.**

**- the collection and or purchase of preliminary data?**

**A: No, if such data will be used for research purposes.**

**Yes, if such data are substantial for the project proposal submission.**

**5) Q: Applicants to Starting Grant have to hold a contractual relationship with UNITN lasting until the end of the activities for which they are using the grant. Is this interpretation correct?**

**A: Yes.**

**6) Q: What is meant by post-doc collaborators? Co.co.co, other contracts or teaching contracts?**

**A: Post-docs holding a contract for research activities (teaching contracts holders are excluded from this call).**
