

PsyHuman Summer School 2023 – Arrival Info Kit

<p>When and Where</p>	<p>Activities start on Monday morning, 19 June and finish on Friday afternoon, 30 June 2023. Academic activities will take place at the Department of Psychology and Cognitive Science. Seminars will be held at Palazzo Piomarta, corso Bettini 84, Rovereto. Some workshops will take place in the Italian garden of Palazzo Fedrigotti, Corso Bettini 31 (just opposite to Palazzo Piomarta). Class attendance and participation in all activities in the program, are compulsory and tracked.</p>
<p>Final screening and Fee Payment</p>	<p>After a final positive screening of your application by UniTrento, on 3rd May you will receive the final admission confirmation as well as all details for the payment of the participation costs. Your enrollment will be considered effective only after the payment has been confirmed. The participation costs must be paid by 15 May 2023.</p>
<p>Enrolment Confirmation and Visa (if needed)</p>	<p>Once your payment has been finalized, we will send you the Enrolment confirmation and, if a visa is needed, your invitation letter. Check whether a visa is needed by selecting your nationality, country of residence, “up to 90 days” and “tourism” options. If you need a visa, please immediately send us the complete name and address of the Italian Embassy/General Consulate in your country where you will go to apply for the visa.</p>
<p>Insurance Coverage</p>	<p>Make sure you have health insurance coverage valid in Italy for the entire period of your stay. If you live in the EU and you have a valid European Health Insurance Card, please refer to this webpage. Otherwise, you will need to buy a private health insurance policy, which covers emergencies and guarantees your return to your country in case of serious health problems, including COVID-related hospitalization and treatment. Among the several choices to consider, you can have a look at Aon Complete Formula which also covers accidents outside academic activities. During all activities organized by UniTrento you are covered by UniTrento accident insurance (only in case of hospitalization due to an accident) and by third party liability (in case of damages you may cause to third parties). Please notice that these are not personal health insurance policies!</p>
<p>Travel Plans</p>	<p>You are required to pay for and organize all travel from your place of residence to Rovereto and back on your own. There is not a designated student pick-up service in Rovereto. The Verona-Catullo airport is the closest airport to Rovereto (20 minutes by shuttle + 1 hour by train), but there are also airports in Milan, Bergamo and Venice. All details and shuttle connections to the closest train station can be found on the webpage How to arrive to Rovereto. Alternatively, FLIXBUS is a cheap way of travelling from the main airports to Rovereto also during the night. If you come by car the highway is the A22 Brennero-Modena and the closest exit to the city center is Rovereto Nord (the other one is Rovereto Sud).</p>
<p>COVID-19 Restrictions</p>	<p>The Green Pass is not mandatory within Italy anymore to access public places or transportation. Make sure you are aware of the covid-related rules during your travel by checking the Useful links section Covid-19 travelers.</p>
<p>Weather and What to Bring</p>	<p>The weather in the region during the Summer is usually sunny and quite warm (up to 35°C). However, it can also be rainy at times with afternoon storms, so a rain jacket and waterproof shoes are recommended. There will also be two excursions in the mountains with walks on trails, so we also suggest that you bring a small backpack, long pants, a fleece jacket or sweater, a small picnic blanket or towel, a hat, sunscreen and sunglasses. Since some classes will take place outside in the garden of the Fedrigotti Building, we recommend that you bring a power bank for your laptop computer. Wi-fi is available in Fedrigotti Building using your UniTrento full user credentials.</p>

<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>As previously mentioned, you are responsible for booking and covering the entire cost of your own lodging in Rovereto for the duration of the Summer School.</p> <p>We suggest the Youth Hostel, which is near the Department of Psychology and Cognitive Science. It is very modern, well equipped and you can find 3 or 4-bed rooms with breakfast included at very convenient prices.</p> <p>Or, if you prefer, you can opt for one of the following alternatives:</p> <p>Air B&B – Rovereto, Booking.com – Rovereto, More hotels - from UniTrento webpage, see Rovereto section</p> <p>Since lessons start on Monday morning and finish on Friday afternoon of the following week, we suggest that you plan your check-in by Sunday evening 18 June and the checkout starting from Friday 30 June.</p> <p>Through the Padlet that will be created soon after the selection, you can contact the other students for a shared accommodation.</p> <p>Rovereto is a tiny town and very popular with tourists, so please make sure to book ahead of time. Ask for and clearly understand the payment and cancellation policy, as well as additional services that may be available (e.g. cleaning, special requests, breakfast, kitchenette, etc.).</p> <p>The Hostel and the hotels provide Trentino Guest Card, in all other cases (e.g. private owners such as Air B&B), you might not have it. This card gives you free access to some museums, all public transportation within the province of Trento and discounts at participating vendors. When you book, ask if you have right to it and at the check in, ask it to be activated.</p> <p>Please let us know in advance if you will have the Card. This Card is welcome (if you have it) for the workshop at the Contemporary Art Museum (MART). UniTrento will cover the entrance tickets to the museum for those of you who might not have it.</p>
<p>Meals</p>	<p>Lunch breaks are normally 2 hours to give you enough time to eat lunch and rest. You will receive meal vouchers for lunches from Monday to Friday in the University restaurant Gilda (Via Prati, 3/b on the corner of Via Matteo del Ben). You can check the daily menu and list of allergens by using the Opera4U App, more information will be provided.</p> <p>This cost will be covered by UniTrento. You can have either a “full” or “partial” meal and make sure the cashier takes notice of which one you choose. The full meal consists of 3 pieces, the partial consists of 2 pieces.</p> <p>Dinners are served à la carte in a Restaurant nearby (the name will be given to you upon arrival). The first 15 euros per dinner are covered by UniTrento by presenting a coupon issued by UniTrento. Any extra cost is at your charge.</p> <p>The welcome coffee break, the lunch during the one-day excursion, the farewell lunch are also covered by UniTrento.</p> <p>Breakfast and week end meals are not included in the meal plan.</p>
<p>ECTS Credits</p>	<p>At the end of the Winter School, all participants will receive an Attendance Certificate.</p> <p>In order to receive an official UniTrento Transcript of Records with 6 ECTS and an evaluation mark, external international students have to attend the scheduled online session.</p> <p>In order to obtain 2 more ECTS, external students can arrange extra work.</p> <p>On the first day you will be asked to inform us about your interest in the 2 extra ECTS.</p> <p>See for the details in the download of the Summer School webpage - “Syllabus and Assessment Tasks”.</p>
