What we did

Barbecues and aperitifs

We have started living again all the University spaces: in addition to the aperitifs organized by the student associations outside the buildings, also the Departments' barbecues are back, occasions to say goodbye before the summer.

CLA

It will be possible to include super-numerary language teaching activities above the level needed for a degree, as long as the required language level has already been reached.

Unless otherwise stipulated in the department's Didactic Regulations, super-numerary language teaching activities do not give CFUs and can be acquired only by examination at CLA.

It will also be possible to include other languages in the curriculum as long as they are added and passed one at a time.

“Movida”

With “Trento si popola”, in collaboration with the Politiche Giovanili, we organized several evenings in Via Suffragio with live music, aperitifs and poetry. The project, which ended with an evening in Via Calepina, showed that the streets of Trento can welcome social moments with live music, and that a positive collaboration can be established between citizens and students.

Post-examination questionnaires

However, at the moment the University decided to confirm only those already tested, due to the low percentage of students who participated.

Furthermore, we proposed to update the questions and make them more specific and useful: we want the post-exam questionnaires to be a tool for giving feedback and reporting any problem. For example: unforeseen topics were asked, the professor was rude, the exam started late or the date was changed on short notice, grades were recorded too late or close to the next call.

We therefore invite you to take a few minutes to compile them, as if the participation will be high we will ask again to extend them to all courses.
