## What we did

### Student e-card

Say goodbye to the physical service card, from now we'll have it on UniTrentoApp! The Student e-card certifies that you are a student even outside the University, for example to obtain discounts. But you need your photo: if you don't have one already, you can upload it on ESSE3.

Next (ambitious) goal? Merging the UniTrento and Opera apps!

### Welfare

We obtained the re-financing of the SIM cards and computers as support measures for the right to study.

### Study rooms and university life

Libraries and study rooms are finally back to their pre-covid timetables and in the coming weeks the 100% capacity will be restored.

Aperitifs in the Departments are finally back! Also Suoni Universitari, the musical contest in which soloists and groups composed of students compete, will be held every Wednesday until December 1<sup>st</sup> at the SanbàPolis theatre.

### Didactics

We presented the DAD monitoring to the Vice-Rector for Teaching and Learning, which shows that some professors do not provide materials for people who do not attend. In order to improve the situation, a professor will be nominated in each department to ensure that all courses are held following the guidelines. Reports regarding DAD should be made to them.

### CLA

Language courses for non-attending students have been organized, which are especially useful for the many courses where a compulsory language level is required.

### Movida

Together with the Students' Council of the City of Trento, we have asked the Mayor to suspend the ordinance for Piazza Santa Maria Maddalena, and have obtained that until November 9<sup>th</sup> it will be postponed from 10 to 11:30 pm, and from November 20<sup>th</sup>, with the opening of the Christmas market, it will be possible to drink mulled wine in the stalls again. We are working with the City Council on a project to make Piazza Dante a place where students can meet and socialize without disturbing residents.

### Graduation's rooms capacity

From the next graduation session, the number of accompanying persons will be increased (now it is 3) up to 50% of the room capacity.

### Erasmus grants

Given the delay in the arrival of EU funds, UniTrento has used its own funds to advance the scholarships for people departing in September, albeit with some inevitable delays, which are now being solved.



## **What we are working on**

### **Facilities**

We are working to return to using the spaces as pre-Covid, for example restoring the benches in the courtyards where this has not been done yet, being able to eat inside the buildings and using the lockers for suitcases. We're holding a dialogue to open a night study room.

### **Transportation**

We are proposing a monitoring (which you can find on the Instagram pages of the students' associations) on the Trento-Rovereto railway line, in order to ask Trentino Trasporti to improve the service in terms of frequency and timetables.

### **Students' residences**

The Opera representatives have started a cycle of periodic meetings with those who live in student residences to monitor the housing situation. In particular, we have proposed to Opera to increase the number of washing machines and reduce the tariffs, and we are working on the reopening of the SanbàPolis bar.

### **University Strategic Plan**

We are taking part in the debate on the PSdA, a document that sets the vision and objectives that the University wants to achieve in the coming years. The topic is very technical and complex, but it is an important opportunity to influence the future of our University. Our aim is to ensure a focus on our needs in this planning.

### **Canteens**

To solve the overcrowding in the canteens, we are working to reopen the Povo 0 canteen. We are maintaining a dialogue on meal portions.

### **National Day of the University Students**

Together with all the Presidents of the Student Councils of the other universities, we are working on establishing the first National Day of University Students on November 17th. This will be an opportunity to bring the vision and needs of the university students to the public's attention. We will meet in Rome the two Ministers for Universities and Equal Opportunities to present to them our requests, including the possibility to vote for non-resident students, teaching innovations, and the increase in economic support for the right to study.
