What we did

Extension of the graduation session a.y. 2021/2022

The Italian Parliament has approved the 2021/2022 academic year prolongation, determining the possibility to have an additional Graduation Session for the students enrolled in this academic year. Consequently, allowing many graduands not to fall outside prescribed time, or anyway they won't have to enroll into another academic year (and pay the corresponding taxes) to attend the final examination. For all students the due date for third fee installment is postponed to June 2023. As Representatives we have taken steps to obtain the best compliance to this measure. The DAO-Conad convention was signed. It will allow students to obtain discount vouchers for grocery shopping, with a discount value of €3, €6 or €15, by buying a prepaid card (respectively of €30, €50 or €100) that can be used in one of the five adherent supermarkets.

Public transports towards Povo, Mesiano and S. Michele all'Adige

We are creating two questionnaires that will be published in the following months to comprehend the needs for the public transport system towards Povo, Mesiano and C3A (S. Michele all'Adige).

Didactics for students unable to attend classes

We are working on the creation of new measures involving the students unable to attend classes. With these we aim to obtain the delivery of online materials, specifically created for non-attending students, in order to facilitate the study. We also set the goal to guarantee more flexibility in the possibility to attend exam sessions, to meet the needs of all.

Extend Free circulation pass

We have made contact with the Students' Provincial Council of Trentino, Alto Adige/Südtirol and Tiröl to evaluate jointly the possibility to extend the public transport agreements of the corresponding provincial services. The ultimate goal would be to obtain agreements for discounted prices allowing the use of public transport also outside of Trentino, for example from Trento to Bolzano or from Trento to Verona.

University Sustainability

Together with the Rector's sustainability delegate we are forming groups of students interested in the sustainability topic. The aim would be to formulate suggestions regarding the energy usage in the University buildings, the sustainability of university canteens, waste recycling and other aspects of everyday life that can make the difference in the way we use the (scarce) resources of our planet.

Series of meetings on anxiety management

In the period April-June 2023, the anxiety management program, offered by the Psychological Counseling Service of the University of Trento, will be activated again.

The meetings on anxiety management aim to let participants learn about the psychophysiological mechanisms of anxiety, as well as associated thoughts, emotions and behaviour. In a group context, in which debate and sharing will be encouraged, participants will experience breathing techniques, muscle relaxation, guided fantasies and cognitive strategies aimed at understanding and managing situations that cause discomfort.

The course is reserved for students of the University of Trento (with groups of 10 participants) and includes 7 group meetings, of 2 hours each, which will be held on a weekly basis at the School of Innovation (Via Tommaso Gar, 16/ 2, 38122 Trento TN).

The meetings will be held in Italian and a contribution is requested for participation.

Before the actual registration, an online information meeting will be held, which may be useful for answering any question or doubt about the activity.
