How to reach Trento

By plane

The following airports are the closest to Trento:

- Verona "Catullo" Airport (*Suggested Airport*)
- Venezia "Marco Polo" Airport
- Venezia - Treviso "Canova" Airport
- Milano – Bergamo "Orio al Serio" Airport

Please find below further information about the travel from each airport to Trento with public transportation.

From each airport is also possible to rent a car with driver (further information in the "rent a car" section).

Verona "Catullo" Airport (*Suggested Airport*)

If you plan to reach Trento by plane, we suggest you to choose Verona "Catullo" Airport. The airport is connected via bus with Verona Train Station (Aerobus: first stop at 5:35 a.m. then from 6:30 a.m. to 11:35 p.m. every 20').

From Verona Train Station you can reach Trento in 1 hour by train, please check timetable on [Trenitalia](#) website.

Venezia "Marco Polo" Airport

The Marco Polo airport is connected via bus with Mestre Train Station (bus [ATVO](#) or [ACTV](#) bus line n.15) and with Venezia "Santa Lucia" Train Station (bus [ATVO](#) or [ACTV](#) line 5-AeroBus).

From Mestre (or Venezia Santa Lucia) train station you can reach Trento in 3 hours (most travel options require a change in Verona). Please check timetable on [Trenitalia](#) website.

Venezia – Treviso "Canova" Airport

The airport is connected to Treviso and Mestre train stations ([ACTT](#) or ATVO buses). From Treviso train station you can reach Mestre station (30 minutes) and then Trento in 3 hours (most travel options require a change in Verona). Milano – Bergamo “Orio al Serio” Airport

Milano “Orio al Serio” Airport is connected via bus (about 1 hour) to Milano train station: there are two companies providing this service (*Orioshuttle* and *Autostradale*). From Milano train station you can reach Trento in 3 hours (most travel options require a change in Verona) please check timetable on [Trenitalia](#) website.

Milano - Malpensa

The Malpensa airport in Milan is divided into two terminals. Both national and international airlines are based in Terminal 1, while low cost airlines (at the moment only EasyJet) are based in Terminal 2. To move between Malpensa 1 and Malpensa 2, there is a free shuttle-bus service in operation 24 hours a day, with departures every 7 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes at night (from 10.45 p.m. to 5.15 a.m.).

From Malpensa **bus services** are available connecting the airport to Milano Central train station.

You can reach Milan directly from the Terminal 1 by **TRENORD/Malpensa Express trains or, via Gallarate, by Trenitalia trains**.

- 1) TRENORD/Malpensa Express trains connect the Terminal 1 of Malpensa directly to the centre of Milan (7 daily trips from Malpensa Airport to Milan Central Station. Travel time: 43 minutes). For more information on tickets and timetables, please visit www.malpensaexpress.it/en/

- 2) You can reach Milan also by Trenitalia trains departing from Gallarate. A bus service (S.A.C.O. Srl. Telefax 0331/251777 +39.0331.258411) is available from the Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 of Malpensa to Gallarate Railway Station. Milano - Linate

Milano Linate airport is connected via bus (STARFLY, www.starfly.net, departures every 30 minutes, on-board ticketing, every day) . From Milano Central Station you can reach Trento in 3 hours (most travel options require a change in Verona) please check timetable on [Trenitalia](#) website.

By train

Two main lines reach Trento : the "Brennero" line (connecting Trento to Rome and the south of Italy and to Innsbruck and northern Europe) and the "Valsugana" line to Venice. Timetable details from [Trenitalia](#) or [Deutsche Bahn](#).

By car or coach

Trento may be accessed by the following roads: "Strada Statale dell'Abetone e del Brennero", "Autostrada del Brennero", "Superstrada della Valsugana" for those coming from Venice, and "Strada Statale 45 bis (Gardesana Occidentale)", for those coming from Brescia.

Town travel

The town has an efficient urban and extra urban travel system run by [Trentino Trasporti SpA](#). If you visit the office at the main railway station you can pick up a free timetable guide.
