Alberto Bellini (S'96–M'99) was born in Italy in 1969.

He received the Laurea (M.S.) degree in Electronic Engineering and the Ph.D. degree in Computer Science and Electronics Engineering from the University of Bologna, Bologna, Italy, in 1994 and 1998, respectively.

From 1999 to 2004, he was with the University of Parma, Parma, Italy.

He was an Honorary Scholar with the University of Wisconsin – Madison, Madison, WI, USA, in 2000.

From 2004 to 2013, he was with the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, Reggio Emilia, Italy.

Since 2013, he has been an Associate Professor of electric machines and drives with the Department of Electrical Engineering, University of Bologna.

He is the author or coauthor of more than 100 papers and one textbook and is the holder of three industrial patents.

His research interests include electric drive design and diagnosis, power electronics, and signal processing for industrial applications and audio.

Dr. Bellini serves as an Associate Editor of the IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON INDUSTRIAL ELECTRONICS.

He was the recipient of the First Prize Paper Award from the Electric Machines Committee of the IEEE Industry Applications Society in 2001.
