



The School will take place at the **Polo Scientifico e Tecnologico "Fabio Ferrari"** of the **University of Trento** (Italy).

The [city of Trento](#) is situated at 190 metres altitude, in the autonomous Italian [Region of Trentino Alto-Adige](#), close to the world-famous mountains called Dolomites. It has a rich history, dating back to Roman times, and nowadays it is an important town along the Venice-Verona and Bolzano-Innsbruck route. The country around Trento is of extraordinary beauty, with its unique mountains and lakes.

How to reach the Polo scientifico e tecnologico

The **venue** of the School is the Polo scientifico e tecnologico "Fabio Ferrari", a building belonging to the University of Trento and located on the east hill of Trento, in the village of **Povo** (5 km from the centre of Trento, in via Sommarive 5).

The participants may reach the venue [by bus](#) (please see also the next paragraph "Travel in the city"): **bus nr. 5**, departure in front of the **railway station** (15 minutes trip, **arrival at the bus stop called "Facoltà di Scienze"**).

The bus tickets have to be bought **BEFORE getting on the bus**.

How to reach Trento

By car or coach

You can reach Trento by the following roads:

- Strada Statale dell'Abetone e del Brennero (SS12);
- Autostrada del Brennero from Modena to Brennero (A22 motorway), phone (+39) 0461 980085; if you travel on the A22, it is necessary to take the Trento Sud exit (Trento centro is closed) and follow the SS12 direction Trento centro;
- Superstrada della Valsugana for those coming from Venice (SS47);
- Strada Statale Gardesana Occidentale (SS45 bis) for those coming from Brescia.

By train

There are two main lines that reach Trento:

- the Brennero line (from Rome to Innsbruck);
- the Valsugana line (from Venice to Trento). From Venice it may be faster to take a train to Verona and then from Verona to Trento.

By plane

Verona Catullo Airport (90 km): this airport is the best option to reach Trento, having direct flight connections with the main European airports.

There are frequent connections to the railway station of Trento also from the following airports: **Venezia Marco Polo** (195 km), **Milano Linate** (245 km), **Milano Malpensa** (300 km).
