Massimo Pompili was born in Rome, Italy, on September 16, 1956.

He received the Dr.Ing. degree and the Ph.D. degree in Electrical Engineering from Sapienza Università di Roma in 1981 and 1985, respectively.

He joined the same University as Researcher in 1989 and since 1993, has been an Associate Professor of Components and Electrical Technologies.

Since 1987, he has been the Chairman of TC10 Fluids for Electrotechnical Application of the Italian CEI, and since 1988, he has been the Secretary of the same IEC Technical Committee.

His main interests concern electrical technology with particular reference to dielectric fluids and the characterization of new materials to be employed in electrical power components.

He is the author of many papers, presented at international conferences or published in the permanent Italian and international scientific literature.

In 2008 he was honored with the "IEEE Hans Tropper Memorial Lecture," presented at the ICDL, Poitiers, France.

He is Associate Editor of the IEEE Transactions on Dielectric and Electrical Insulation and Guest Editor of several Special Issues of IEEE Transactions.

He is also the Italian Representative of CIGRE SC-D1 "Materials and Emerging Test Techniques".
