Wolfgang Streicher was working from 1986 to 2009 at the Institute of Thermal Engineering at Graz University of Technology.

He took over the chair of energy efficient buildings and Renewable Energy at University of Innsbruck in December 2009.

Since 7/2012 he is leading the Unit of Energy Efficient Buildings. His expertise covers HVAC systems, energy efficient buildings, solar thermal energy use (active and passive), renewable energy use in buildings, thermal energy storage, thermal building and HVAC system simulation, numerical methods and energy certification of buildings and especially the systems integration of all these parts. He was and is involved in numerous national and international research projects in this field.

In 2011 he concluded a study for the Federal Austrian Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, Environment and Water Management about the possibility of Austria being energy autonomous.

He is member of the Austrian Standardization Institute in three groups.
