	of the defining factors throughout all areas of study. Co-enrollment: If academically relevant, exchange students can coenroll at other Graz universities (e.g., Graz Univ. of Technology, Kunstuniversität Graz) after arrival at no extra cost. A min of 50 % of ECTS during the exchange must be taken at University of Graz. Courses taken at another Graz university will come on a separate transcript.

It is the student's responsibility to contact each professor as early as possible in the application process and definitely before finalizing travel plans in case they need to return to their home universities before the end of the exchange semester at Uni Graz. Early exams are NOT_available for lecture-type courses at the Faculty of Business and of the field of English and American Studies. For other types of courses such as pro-seminars, seminars professors have the last say.
