Students apply via Studielink and upload all the required documents to Osiris Aanmeld. 2. Application is assessed by Tilburg University. 3. International Admissions Coordinators send admission letters to applicants, with cc to University of Trento 4. Students will receive a handbook from the International Admissions Coordinator after she received the nominations from Trento University. 2. The student will follow all steps in this handbook to correctly apply for the program. 3. International Admissions Coordinator and the Program Director at Tilburg University will check the application. After the application has been confirmed as complete, admitted applicants will get an admission letter within 4-6 weeks, with Trento in cc.

All students with an EU or EEA nationality who do not yet have a Dutch Master's degree are required to pay these fees, referred to as the statutory fees. The tuition fees for non-EEA/EU nationals and EEA/EU nationals who already have a Dutch Master's degree are determined by universities themselves. These fees are referred to as the institutional fees. Both the statutory and institutional fees are published on Tilburg University's website.
