After the application has been confirmed as complete, admitted applicants will get an admission letter within 4- 6 weeks, with Trento in cc.</li> </ol>

	<b>Tilburg U statutory and institutional fees</b> Every year the Minister of Education determines the statutory fee for full-time programs in higher education. All students with an EU or EEA nationality who do not yet have a Dutch Master's degree are required to pay these fees, referred to as the statutory fees.
	The tuition fees for non-EEA/EU nationals and EEA/EU nationals who already have a Dutch Master's degree are determined by universities themselves. These fees are referred to as the institutional fees. Both the statutory and institutional fees are published on Tilburg University's website.
