Public transport

The bus stops located near the Centre are S. Francesco Porta Nuova and Port'Aquila (bus lines: 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 in different directions). These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. To reach the Centre continue along via Galileo Galilei (from San Francesco Porta Nuova) or via Livio Marchetti (from Port'Aquila), both streets converge in via S. Maria Maddalena. The building does not have a sign but can be identified by its civic number plate. There is no blister paving or acoustic signals.

Own transportation means



The Centre is located within the limited traffic Zone (red ZTL). The entrance gates are in via Galileo Galilei and in via Livio Marchetti.

UniTrento staff parks in a reserved underground parking lot with an entrance in via Tommaso Gar (900 meters away from the Centre). The lift, equipped with *braille* buttons, does not provide direct access to the building, but has its own exit from where is possible to get access to the structure.

Guests can arrange access to the parking lot by e-mailing the Centre secretariat to obtain authorisation. Upon the arrival, they should call the reception at +39 0461 281717. The staff will open the gates at entrance and exit.

Accessibility indications

The building accesses are barrier-free and allow independent access. The hallways are spacious, passables and regularly paved. Each classroom (except the computer rooms) is equipped with dedicated stations. The building has five accessible toilets, available on all floors. Two lifts with *braille* buttons are available in the two wings of the structure. Only the lift in the “old” wing goes up to the third floor. The stairs do not provide any information about the number of steps or the floor number reached.
