## **Public transport**

The bus stop is located in Via Rosmini (Rosmini Santa Maria Maggiore stop), a dozen metres or so from the building entrance.

The following bus lines reach the Directorate (leaving from the train station): bus line number 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14 and 17 (non-working days only). These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. From the bus stop, head south on Via Rosmini until you reach the crossroads with Via Verdi, cross the road at the traffic lights and then head straight on



Via Rosmini, passing the Department of Economics and Management building until you reach the crossroads with Via di Briamasco, then turn right and carry straight on. Once you have passed the junction with Via Inama, carry straight on until you reach the building entrance (follow the signs from the car park). Alternatively, you can access the building from the inner courtyard of Molino Vittoria, passing the building and going through a small gate to arrive near the entrance to the Directorate offices. The route is accessible for people with motor disabilities and wheelchair users; there is no blister paving or acoustic signals.

## Own transportation means

UniTrento staff use the reserved stalls at street level, with access from Via Verdi, up from Palazzo Cavazzani, or other assigned parking spaces. To enter the building, leave the inner courtyard and take Via Verdi, from where you can reach the main entrance. There are no architectural barriers along the way, but please note that there is no pavement.

Guests can park in the stalls in Via Inama, displaying their badge, and, from there, they can reach the entrance to the facilities.

## Accessibility indications

Building entrances are barrier-free (there is a metal ramp connecting the pavement to the building entrance) and allow visitors to autonomously access the facilities.



No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive.
