Public transport

The bus stop is located in Via Rosmini (Rosmini Santa Maria Maggiore stop), a dozen metres or so from the building entrance.

The following bus lines reach the Department (leaving from the train station): bus line number 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14 and 17 (non-working days only). These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. From the bus stop, head south on Via Rosmini until you reach the crossroads with Via Verdi, cross the road and turn right onto Via Verdi, passing the Department of Economics and Management until the crossroads with Via



Inama; turn left and you arrive at the building entrance. There is no blister paving or acoustic signals.

Own transportation means

UniTrento staff use the reserved underground car park, with entrance from Via Rosmini. You can enter the building directly from the car park, taking the lift near the two reserved stalls that connects all of section A. To reach the other parts of the building, exit on floor 0 (reception) and use the dedicated ramp to reach section B.

Guests can arrange access to the car park by contacting reception on: +39 0461 282100. A member of staff will open the gate to let cars in and out. Alternatively, you can park directly on Via Inama in the dedicated stalls, displaying your badge.

Accessibility indications

Access points and entrances to the location are barrier-free and allow visitors to autonomously access the three sections making up the facilities.

All lecture halls, laboratories, seminar and conference rooms, studios, offices and reading rooms can be accessed independently. The building has wide, practicable corridors with even flooring. The lifts have a Braille control panel. No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive.
