### Public transport

The easiest bus stop to access the facilities is in Via Sommarive (Povo Facoltà di Scienze stop), a dozen metres or so from the building entrance.

The following bus lines reach the Departments (leaving from the train station): bus line number 5, 5/ and 13. These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. From the bus stop, you can access the main entrance and, from there, reach the various buildings making up the Povo Zero complex.

## **Own transportation means**

UniTrento staff use the reserved parking spaces with access from Via Sommarive 14, near the main entrance.

Authorised guests can park in the car park in front of the main entrance to the Centre, reporting to reception, and, from there, they can access the main body of the facilities.

## **Accessibility indications**

You can access the building directly through the main entrance.

Lecturers' offices, study rooms, almost all laboratories, the reception, coffee areas and canteen are accessible, and the corridors allow for adequate manoeuvrability. The building has wide, practicable corridors with even flooring. There are five dedicated toilets on the various floors and in the buildings making up the Centre. The lifts have Braille control panels. No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive.
