Public transport

The following bus lines reach the Faculty (leaving from the train station): bus line number 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14 and 17 (non-working days only). These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free", and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. The bus stop is located on Via Rosmini (Rosmini Santa Maria Maggiore stop), a dozen metres or so from the building entrance. To reach the entrance from the bus stop, head south along Via Rosmini and turn left at the traffic lights onto Via Verdi, towards the entrance to the Faculty of Law. The traffic light also has a call-button pedestrian crossing. There is no blister paving or acoustic signals.



Own transportation means

UniTrento staff use the reserved underground car park, where there are three dedicated stalls. To access the Faculty, however, you must leave the car park gate and head along Via Rosmini until you reach the crossroads, then turn left onto Via Verdi towards the entrance to the Faculty. Guests can arrange access to the car park by calling +39 0461 281818. A member of staff will open the gate to let cars in and out.

Alternatively, you can park directly on Via Verdi or Via Rosmini, displaying your badge.

Please note: between 6.00 and 13.00 each Thursday, these roads are closed for the weekly market.

Accessibility indications

The faculty has "barrier-free" paths; the entrance is positioned lower than the reception: there is a lift to the left that allows you to independently reach the various floors inside the faculty. The building has wide, practicable corridors with even flooring.

All lecture rooms, laboratories, seminar and conference rooms, presidential and secretarial offices, lecturers' offices, copy rooms, reading rooms and refreshment areas are accessible.

The lifts have Braille control panels. No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive. There are 12 dedicated toilet facilities, located on the various floors.
