Public transport

The bus stop is located in Via Rosmini (Rosmini Santa Maria Maggiore stop), about a hundred meters from the building entrance.

The following bus lines reach the department (leaving from the train station): bus line number 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14 and 17 (non-working days only).

These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. From the bus stop, head south on Via Rosmini until you reach the first crossroads and then turn right onto Via Zanella, continuing until you reach the



end of the road. There is a pedestrian crossing to reach the Department entrance. There is no blister paving or acoustic signals.

Own transportation means

UniTrento staff park in the three dedicated stalls in the reserved underground car park (entrance on Via Tommaso Gar). The lift, equipped with a Braille control panel, does not access the building directly; instead, it has an independent exit from where you can reach the building entrance. From here, you can take the lift to reach all the floors in the building.

Guests can arrange access to the car park by sending an e-mail to the Department of Literature in order to obtain authorisation. Upon arrival, guests must then contact reception on: +39 0461 281717. A member of staff will open the gate to let cars in and out.

Alternatively, you can park directly on Via Tommaso Gar in the dedicated stalls, displaying your badge.

Accessibility indications

Building entrances are barrier-free and allow visitors to autonomously access the facilities. The building has wide, practicable corridors with even flooring. There are dedicated stations in each classroom. The building has six dedicated toilets.

The lifts have Braille control panels. No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive.
