Public transport

The bus stop is located in Via Rosmini (Rosmini Santa Maria Maggiore stop), a dozen metres or so from the building entrance. The following bus lines reach the department (leaving from the train station): 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14 and 17 (non-working days only). These urban service bus lines are "barrier-free" and all vehicles have a super-lowered platform, with an extractable support to allow for wheelchairs to get on/off easily, as well as reserved places complete with safety belt. From the bus stop, head south on Via Rosmini until the crossroads with Via Verdi and then turn left onto Via Verdi. It is possible to cross the road following a route with traffic lights all the way along, offering call-button pedestrian crossings. There is no blister paving or acoustic signals.



Own transportation means

UniTrento staff use the two stalls in the ground-level reserved car park on Via Rosmini. The building entrance can be reached directly from the car park. Guests can arrange access to the car park by contacting the reception service on +39 0461 281300; reception staff will open the gate upon entry and exit. Alternatively, it is possible to park directly on Via Verdi or Via Rosmini, displaying your badge.

Please note: every Thursday between 6.00 and 13.00, Via Verdi is closed for the weekly market.

Accessibility indications

The location has barrier-free entrances and pathways to the east and west side, and to the south (also entering via the car park). People with motor disabilities who do not belong to the Department of Sociology and Social Research must call the intercom to access the building.

The lifts have Braille control panels. No information is displayed along the stairs regarding the number of steps or the floor number when you arrive.

There are four dedicated toilets on the various floors of the building.

Please note: the studies on the third floor (attic) are not "barrier-free".
