The **Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management (BEM)** aims to provide you with a comprehensive understanding of the foundations of economic and managerial sciences by applying a wide range of skills and technical competencies to model, understand and manage complex scenarios that involve various economic factors.

The BEM programme focuses on creative teaching and integration of the main subjects involved in **economic decisions: economic and managerial sciences, law and quantitative methods with an in-depth exploration of the fields of computer science, big data and artificial intelligence.**

Different teaching methods will be implemented to help you acquire specialized competences: practical labs, projects and seminars will train you to integrate theoretical foundations with practical applications.

During the BEM programme, you will develop important soft skills such as communication, team-work and self-directed learning and you will be trained to apply your skills creatively and independently in order to adapt yourself to every situation you will face.

By attending this programme, you will be able to analyze and respond to diverse business and economic scenarios by applying at the highest level the variety of tools you have acquired during the BEM Programme.
