<b>Destination</b>	Washington University in St. Louis, School of Law (USA) – Transnational Law Program (TLP) and Transnational Global Law Making Program (TGP)
<b>Scholarships provided</b>	5 for the 5-year Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale a ciclo unico) in Law (TLP) 2 for the 2-year Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale) in Global Law Making (TGP)
<b>Scholarship amount</b> <i>(the amount is gross)</i>	Basic semester scholarship: € 3,500 + integration of € 1,250 if ISEE ≤ € 25,000 A one-time lump sum contribution of € 1,500 for travel expenses.
<b>Possible mobility places without scholarship</b>	Subject to verification of the partner university's availability, the Selection Committee reserves the right to assign mobility places without a UniTrento scholarship, but with a potential reduced tuition fee (within the limits and terms provided by the agreement) at the partner university.
<b>Objectives</b>	<p>The main objective of the TLP-Transnational Law Program for single-cycle Master's Degree students and the TGP-Transnational Glam Program for Global Law Making Master's Degree students is the creation of a transnational legal education pathway through an integrated teaching path across different faculties. Starting from August 2026, selected students will attend two semesters for the LL.M. at WUSTL. The beginning of the first semester will be preceded by an intensive orientation period.</p> <p>WUSTL ranks among the top 20 American universities (position n. 14 in the 2024 "Best Law Schools" ranking).</p> <p>Upon completion of the study path provided by the TLP and TGP programs, the student will achieve a double degree: a Master's Degree from the University of Trento and an LL.M. from WUSTL.</p>

	<p>Only for 5-year Master's Degree students participating in the TLP program: the LL.M. degree, if obtained according to the methods indicated each year by WUSTL (in particular with reference to the inclusion of specific compulsory courses in the study plan and the achievement of a specific number of credits), will allow—normally after also obtaining the Italian single-cycle degree—to take the Bar Exam for access to the legal profession and, once passed, to practice law in the states of California, New York, and Missouri (for further details, see the web <a href="#">Bar Admission Guide</a> website). To date, the TLP program has been completed by 77 students, 10 of whom have taken the Bar Exam in the State of New York.</p> <p>The LL.M. degree does not grant access to the Bar Exam to Glam Master's Degree students participating in the TGP program.</p>
